3.0 COMMUNICATIONS

3.1 Representative reports:

Azusa: Dr. Contreras reported that an ESL instructor had reported out sick and then the substitute for the teacher had to call out sick so the school was working to address this personnel issue. He reported that Azusa would be starting a Security cohort on October 27 and that the current Phlebotomy program had one more week of classroom before clinical externships would start. He advised the first CNA cohort of the year would finish soon and would be taking

Citrus: Ms. McCraven reported the Citrus Winter and Spring schedules had been posted online and registration would start 11/3. She reported that the new Citrus Director of Continuing Education had been hired and would start by 11/19.

Claremont: Mr. Delvasto reported that Claremont had recent issues with the school's Career Tech Counselor, but they had just hired a new one who was a rock start so they were hopeful problems would be turned around. He reported that new CNA cohort was starting soon and they had a nearly full class due to targeted marketing efforts.

Duarte: No report.

Glendora: Ms. Shibata reported that the Glendora K-12 Parent success class had an enrollment of 31 students. She noted that the school was going through procedures to attract new adult students to the program.

Monrovia: Mr. Fertig reported the last CNA cohort had excellent testing results with a 100% pass rate. He advised that the new CNA cohort was full from targeted marketing efforts. He reported that recently the school had earned over \$200,000 from Certified Medi-Cal Peer Support Specialist training cohorts which had helped immensely with the loss of WIOA 243 funds.
